### **Operations**

Empyrean currently has 55 wells in production in total at the Sugarloaf Project. In addition there are currently 3 wells being drilled and a further 4 wells in the process of having completion/ stimulation operations carried out.

The fundamental data coming through is strong and shows improvement in some wells.
